

Please see details of your bike hire collection/set up below.

**Your bike will be available on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September from 1pm until 10pm at Cawdor Castle, Nairn IV12 5RD**

There is no option to collect your bike on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September.

**Please provide your bike hire booking number when you check in with us.**

This is essential and helps speed up your journey time collecting your bike

This is the time to set your up bike, test ride and get your accessories fitted.

Once your bike is set up you will leave it overnight in the secure bike storage compound at Cawdor Castle.

We will assist you with fitting pedals, saddles, and accessories, and setting up the bike to suit you.

**Helmets and SPD pedals must be pre ordered and paid for,** if you still require these items you can go onto our website and book individually. Quote your booking number so we can match this to your bike hire booking. We do not rent out shoes, you must bring your own!

The bikes will be supplied with standard flat pedals if no other option is pre booked.

The bike comes fitted with two bottle cages, (no bottles) a pump and a seat pack containing a tube and tyre levers. We will have water bottles for sale if you need to buy them.

You are welcome to bring your own extra kit and we will help to fit and remove.

Tube size required is 700 x 20-28 presta valve 60mm. This will suit all bikes hired

We will have a range of essential spares for sale should you forget anything.

### **Bike collection at the finish**

1-day –Your bike will be collected from the Fort William transition on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September, we will have a mechanic there to assist with removing pedals and other kit.

2-day – Your bike will be collected from the Fort William transition on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September. we will have a mechanic there to assist with removing pedals and other kit.

Please ensure all personal items, including pedals, have been removed.
